Monthly, CBRM is going to profile area ministries and this month we'd like to introduce Pastor Scott Terry and his family of Christ Fellowship Church, South Portland, ME.

Scott and his wife Julie have two sons: Sam (age 20, studying Chemical Engineering at UMaine, Orono) and Jacob (age 17, a senior at Scarborough High School).

They have lived in Maine for 5 years and lived in Vermont 2 years prior.

Scott worked in underwriting management for State Farm Ins for 12 years before being called to gospel ministry.

He served as associate pastor at Belle Aire Baptist Church in Murfreesboro, TN for 5 years and served as assistant pastor at Christ Memorial Church in Williston, VT for 2 years, while participating in a residency program at the NETS Institute for Church Planting.

Scott and Julie began evangelistic Bible studies and

gathered a core group in their home in Scarborough.

And launched Christ Fellowship Church in South Portland, ME on Easter Sunday of 2012.

Christ Fellowship Church:

The church is a ministry of the Word. "We are a gospel-driven church; meaning that the good news of Jesus Christ informs everything we do; preaching, teaching, counseling, serving, living and praying."

Their radical commitment is to preach Jesus Christ and Him crucified so that the faith of the people of Portland, Maine, would rest not in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. "By His grace we are seeing the power of God on display in the salvation of sinners and in the building up of the saints. Our people are equipped to witness winsomely for Christ everywhere they go with everyone they meet in their daily lives."
